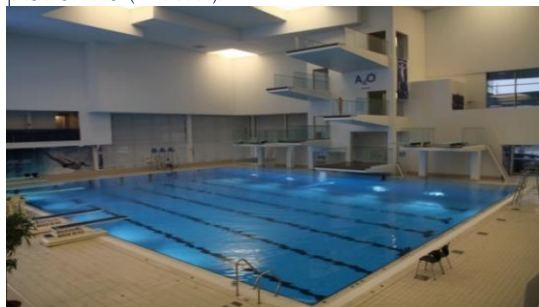

Entry Fee

The entry fee is 150 NOK (about €15) per start for the individual events, and 200 NOK (about €20) per pair for the synchronized event.

Late entries: Entries arriving after March 11th will be charged 300 NOK (about €30) per start for the individual events, and 400 NOK (about €40) per pair for the synchronized event.

All clubs have to pay the entry before March 10th. Participating clubs will receive an invoice after sending entry-form.

All payment is in Norwegian currency!

Diving Sheets:

Bergen Open will run the DiveCalc program. You will be able to enter the divesheets online.

All sheets will be posted on the results-wall, the day before the event, and changes can be made up to one hour before the event starts.

Accommodation

Booking must be done before the 11th of February 2018.

Invoice-payment is due by 10st of March. There is no refund after this date in case of cancellation or reducing number of rooms.

NB: If teams do not book accommodation via Bergen Diving Club, there will be a 500,- NOK (about 50) payment per day per person as a part of organization costs.

The City of Bergen

Founded in 1070 by King Olav Kyrre, Bergen is an international town with small-town charm and atmosphere. The inhabitants love to show off their beautiful city. They are proud of Bergen's shipping, trading and cultural traditions. The city with its 235,000 inhabitants is like a spectacular amphitheatre clambering up the mountainsides, overlooking the sea, embracing you. You can roam through living history in this modern city, the gateway to the wildest and loveliest fjords of Norway. Tradition, initiative and drive have made Bergen one of Norway's most vigorous cultural cities. It is not merely by chance that Norway's biggest cultural event, the Bergen International Festival, is held here each year, or that the town was chosen to be one of the European Cities of Culture in the year 2000.
