## **Entry Fee**

The entry fee is <u>220 NOK</u> per start for the individual events, and <u>330 NOK</u> per pair for the synchronized event.

<u>Late entries:</u> Entries arriving after April 4<sup>th</sup> will be charged <u>440 NOK</u> per start for the individual events, and <u>660 NOK</u> per pair for the synchronized event.

All clubs must pay the entry before April 20<sup>th</sup>. Participating clubs will receive an invoice after sending entry-form.

## Diving Sheets:

Bergen Open will run the DiveCalc program. You will be able to enter the divesheets online.

All sheets will be posted on the results-wall, the day before the event, and changes can be made up to one hour before the event starts.

## Judges evaluation:

There will be judges evaluation by European Aquatics TDC at Bergen Open.

## Accommodation

Booking must be done before the 25<sup>th</sup> of February 2025.

Any cancellation after this date, you may have to pay the hotel-booking in full (100%). Invoice-payment is due by 20<sup>th</sup> of April.

NB: If teams do not book accommodation via Bergen Diving Club, there will be a 700,- NOK payment per day per person as a part of organization costs.
